Post-Intravitreal Injection Instructions

1. It is completely normal – and painless – to sense some pressure or discomfort in the eye area while being injected.
2. You may experience minor bleeding in the white part of your eye, which will disappear within 1-2 weeks.
3. It is common to see eye floaters (spots in your vision). They will reduce over time.
4. Avoid rubbing your eyes during the first few days post-injection.
5. Use your eye drops as prescribed.
6. Should you experience any sudden complications (pain, redness, discomfort, sensitivity to light, or low vision), speak to your doctor immediately.
7. Make sure to schedule your follow-up appointments as per your doctor's instructions.
